Notes:

We have introduced a “student-plus” membership for those students who are in their first year after graduation, to encourage both new graduates to join and for graduating current student members to maintain their membership. This allows our student and student-plus members to receive all of the benefits of standard membership at reduced rates.

We have introduced concessional rates for those health professional educators from OECD countries receiving Official Development Assistance (ODA) – receiving all of the membership benefits at concessional rates. This was in response to requests from current members to ensure that we are including our Asia-Pacific near neighbours.
